Boardman Township

Connecting Boardman

- Planning activities related to the creation of a Township-wide Active Transportation Plan to promote a healthy community and provide low-cost and safe job access.

City of Canfield

US 224-Canfield Access Management Plan Phase 1

- Phase One of the Access Management Plan will consider US 224 from S.R. 11 to Hillside Drive. This stretch of roadway serves numerous shops, restaurants, and plazas, while providing pedestrian and vehicular access to the surrounding residential neighborhoods.

City of Warren

Downtown Warren Complete Streets

- Development of a complete streets plan, which may include recommendations for traffic calming, wayfinding, improvements to infrastructure and updated parking systems.

City of Youngstown

GIS Sanitary Sewer Network

- Proposed project will involve validating sewer data with pipe types and sizes, slopes, direction of flow including sewer network editing and analysis with the help of Mahoning County GIS Department.

Howland Township

Niles Cortland Road Complete Street Project

- The Planning Grant will determine the feasibility and implementation strategy of incorporating sidewalks and bike lanes into approximately 2.4 miles of Niles Cortland Road in Howland Township to increase healthy mobility opportunities.

Trumbull County Planning Commission

Peninsula Connect- Walkability and Alternative Transportation Plan

- The scope of the project would encompass those parts of Courthouse Square that function as a gateway to the Peninsula, namely the intersection of Market Street and Mahoning Avenue. Bike lanes, road diets, improved lighting, and transit improvements will be a focus of the planning project.

Trumbull County Comprehensive Transportation Study

- Study purpose would be for evaluation of existing system and determine the most effective mode of service delivery for Trumbull County Residents.

Youngstown Bike Share System

- Grant funding will be to the planning phase of the bike share project, which involves identifying the structure and business model, assessing the demand, identifying the bike share area, and creating an operational structure. Grant funding will also be used for planning that is involved in the other phases of the bike share system setup, regarding zoning, local legislation modifications, and permitting.
