IN SUPPORT OF THE TRUMBULL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPLICATION TO THE FY 2017 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION PUBLIC WORKS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Trumbull County Commissioners are submitting a FY 2017 Economic Development Administration Public Works Assistance Grant for the Golden Triangle Infrastructure Improvement Project – Dietz and Industrial Access Road Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Golden Triangle is a regionally significant employment area with a high concentration of industries engaged in manufacturing, material processing, and warehousing and distribution. Over thirty businesses and three-thousand jobs are located in this area; and
