

RESOLUTION
OF THE EASTGATE REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS APPROVING
THE 2010 UPDATE OF THE FEDERAL FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION OF
HIGHWAYS FOR THE EASTGATE AREA

WHEREAS, the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for transportation planning in the Youngstown Metropolitan Area which include in its study area Mahoning and Trumbull Counties; and

WHEREAS, the federal functional classification of highways is updated every ten years following the decennial U.S. Census and establishment of the urban boundary for each urbanized area, and

WHEREAS, for the purpose of establishing smoother boundaries for the purposes of the Federal Functional Classifications (FC) and highway design standards, the adjusted 2010 Census designated Urban Area Boundary within the Eastgate area was adjusted and presented to Eastgate's Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and the Citizens Advisory Board (CAB); and

WHEREAS, the General Policy Board (GPB) of the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments, through GPB Resolution, approved the 2010 Adjusted Urbanized Area Boundary; and

WHEREAS, Eastgate reviewed the 2000 federal FC and submitted several proposed FC revisions to ODOT and the FHWA; and

WHEREAS, Eastgate received minor additional FC reclassification suggestions by ODOT's FC Committee, in which Eastgate concurred; and


WHEREAS, the FHWA and ODOT approved the proposed FC revisions on August 11, 2017.

WHEREAS, the 2010 update of the Federal Functional Classification of Highways for the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments was presented and reviewed by Eastgate's Technical Advisory Committee and Citizen Advisory Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the General Policy Board of the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments, State of Ohio, approves the 2010 update of the Federal Functional Classification of Highways for the Eastgate Regional Council of Governments as presented.
