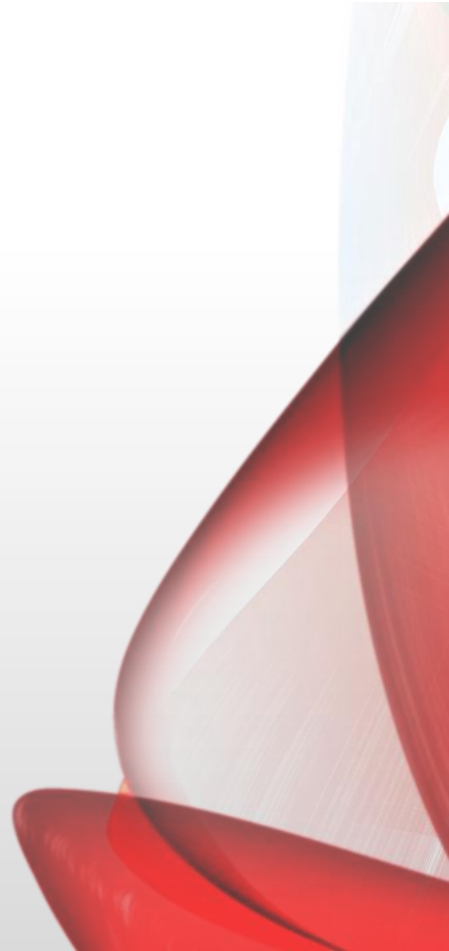

FEDERAL RULE 23 CFR 490 NATIONAL PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT MEASURES

- State DOTs are required to set Safety Performance Measures
- 5 Safety Measures are required
- Serious Injuries, Fatal Injuries, Serious Injury Rate, Fatal Injury Rate, and Non-motorized fatalities and serious injuries
- Creates transparency and accountability in the safety planning process

- This year ODOT has decided to raise the target from a 1% reduction to a 2% reduction



SAFETY GOALS FOR THE STATE

Safety Performance Management Measures	BASELINE	TARGET
Number of Fatalities	1,099	<1,055
Number of Serious Injuries	8,692.2	<8,348
Fatality Rate per 100 Million Vehicle Miles Traveled	0.95	<0.91
Serious Injury Rate per 100 Million Vehicle Miles Traveled	7.51	<7.21
Number of Non-motorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries	858.4	<824
